BitSoc Webinar - "Where do you wish to be after graduation?"

Sri Lanka made a remarkable transition to online tertiary education after closing its higher education institutions response to the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. However, this keeps students away extra-curricular activities and their engagement in learning is found to be minimum. The social distance and discrimination from COVID-19 posing challenges on social cohesion for the mind of students, which may need to be taken care by deliberate counselling with compassion. The career guidance and job placement support at higher education institutions will be increasingly important mitigate concerns of the students for employment.

BitSoc identified above necessities of the students, and organized a webinar series titled "BitSoc Alumini Webinar Series" to support students to identify their career pathways in the field of Agriculture. The first webinar of the above series was conducted on 31st March 2021 with the title "Where do you wish to be after graduation?" via Zoom with the participation of more than 300 undergraduates. Six past graduates specialized in biotechnology who serve for the country under different capacities were invited as guest speakers for the session.







The students got awareness on how to balance their academic and extracurricular activities; how to achieve targets; how to improve interpersonal skills; how to develop job skills *etc*. At the end, there was a question and answers session where lots of questions were raised by the students. The resource persons tried their best to guide the students towards finding their career pathways. As BitSoc, we acknowledge all the guest speakers for the knowledge they have shared with their juniors and commitments they have made adjusting their busy schedules to make this event a success.

BitSoc Outreach - Establishing New Science Laboratory

With the generous support of the Department of Biotechnology and the BitSoc Society a new science laboratory was established at the Malwana Jayanthi Vidyalaya, Kegalle which has classes from grade one to the ordinary level. At the moment Malwana Jayanthi Vidyalaya is a home to fifty one students who are tutored under sixteen teachers. The aim of this exercise was to construct and donate fully equipped science laboratory to the school, since availability of such laboratory facilities will help mastering the competencies of the students. This issue was brought to attention of the Biotechnology Department of Wayamba University of Sri Lanka by Ms Bavani Rajapakshe who is a past student of the Department of Biotechnology and at the moment teacher of the Malwana Jayanthi Vidyalaya. Based on that request, Department of Biotechnology was able to design and construct the laboratory and handover it to the students by the end of March 2021. The designing process of the science laboratory was done by Mr Chinthaka Bandara, Technical Officer/Department of Biotechnology.







The opening of the laboratory was conducted ceremonially with the participation of the academic staff, nonacademic staff and representatives of the BitSoc Society on 25th March 2021. Principal, teachers and students expressed their heartfelt gratitude to all academic and nonacademic staff members, BitSoc representatives and rest of the invitees who have contributed in numerous ways to make this effort a success.










Inter-Batch Collaborative Debate Competition




BitSoc Inter-batch Collaboration

BitSoc organized inter-batch collaborative debate competition concurrent with the biosafety awareness session organized by National Biosafety Project for the students of the Wayamba University, Topic of the debate was "Modern Biotechnology will be Essential for Sustainable Agriculture in Sri Lanka". This debate competition was coordinated by Dr B.L.W.K. Balasooriya, Senior **Lecturer/Department** Biotechnology. Prof. D.P.S.T.G. Attanayaka, Prof. N.S. Kottearachchi and Dr B.L.W.K. Balasooriya served on the judging panel. Twelve students have participated in the initial round and the opposing team won the debate.

Based on the marks scored at the initial round, eight students were selected for the final round conducted during the online webinar on "Awareness Session on National Biosafety Project (Implementation of the National Biosafety Framework in accordance with the Cartagena Protocol on Biosafety)" implemented by the Ministry of Environment through United Nations' Food and Agriculture Organization.
