

Terms of Reference of Student Support Scholarship Scheme

1. **Eligibility:** She/he should be registered as an internal student of the Faculty of Agriculture and Plantation Management and eligible throughout the 2nd year and 3rd year, semester I.
2. **Funds:** The sources of funding for the student support scholarship will be generated from the fee-levying programs offered by the Faculty of Agriculture and Plantation Management at Wayamba University of Sri Lanka. These programs include:

- Master of Agri-Enterprise & Technology Management
- B.Sc. (Plantation Management) External
- B.Sc. (Food Business and Marketing) External
- Diploma in Agriculture and Plantation Management
- Diploma in Modern Agrotechnology
- Diploma in Food Business and Marketing
- Advanced Certificate in Plant Tissue Culture

3. Selection of Students:

Applications can be called from an open advertisement. Selection should be done by the scholarship committee which shall comprise the following members:

- a) Dean of the faculty
- b) Senior Student Counsellor-Makandura Premises as appointed by the faculty board
- c) Student Counsellors of the faculty of Agriculture and Plantation Management as appointed by the faculty board
- d) Financial officer nominated by the Bursar of the University
- e) Assistant Registrar of the Faculty

4. **Instalments:** 10 instalments per an academic year

5. **Value of the instalment:** Monthly instalments for the study period will be decided by the scholarship committee

6. **Method of payment:** Direct deposit to the bank account

The faculty should initiate the voucher for payments

The student should have at least 80% attendance for the period considered

7. Other governing conditions:

7.1 Any student who provides false or inaccurate statements or who fails to disclose any material fact in his/her application is liable to have his scholarship cancelled.
